KHDA Regulations



- KHDA has published its plans for re-opening Dubai schools in September.

Health & Safety

- Round the clock cleaning and sanitising.
- Extensive hand sanitisers and PPE
- Students will eat in designated areas and be supervised and supported to stay safe.
- Students above 6 years of age need to wear face masks.
- Physical social distancing
- Access to areas of the school
- Following discussions with GEMS and the KHDA, the school is encouraging ALL parents to send individual packed lunches with students to reduce the risk of infection. Lunch will be conducted in classrooms with social distancing and strict hygiene rules in place.



Travel & Premises Access



- ▶ Bus running at 50% capacity (with social distancing)
- Entry onto school site No parents allowed into school site or near learning areas/ classrooms

Parking and vehicle access to the school site



- As we plan our reopening, in the first few weeks vehicles will not be permitted access to drive into the school site (as you have previously done for pick and drop off).
- For families who use private vehicles, please park at the back of the school and ensure you adhere to the staggered timings.
- This will help in ensuring congestion is minimised.
- As we progress through the term we will review parental access following a review of our reopening.

- Groups of no more than 10 students in Foundation Stage and Year 1
- Physical distancing allows approx. 16 students in each classroom for Years 2 to Year 10.
- ► PE non-contact sports only
- No ECAs



GFM Reopening Plan - GFM will open safely in September with

- All FS1, FS2, Year 1 and Year 10 students will be allowed on site for face-to-face learning.
- ► FS1, FS2 and Year 1 will operate on a shift system with AM and PM (2 hours and 15 minutes contact time for each shift) sessions engaging directly with their Class Teachers and Teaching Assistants.
- Year 2- 9 will be invited for face-to-face learning on a rotational basis (Day 'on' and Day 'off'). The alternating days will have 'live' online learning.
- Families can opt for 100% remote learning if requested in the survey below.

Siblings



- Siblings will be grouped as to ensure they attend school on the same days in rotational models
- Student groups will be based on houses:
- ► Ambitious Archers & Courageous Knights in one rotation
- Resilient Riders & Respectful Royals in the alternating rotation
